

POLICY ON COMPENSATION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS



The Biomedical doctoral programs will receive compensation for administrative costs for graduate students whose mentors do not provide indirect costs to that program. July 1 of each year each program will provide the Graduate College with a list of currently enrolled students and their mentors who fit this description. The Graduate College will reimburse the program \$1,000/student. For OUHSC faculty members outside the program's home department the Graduate College will bill the outside department. For OMRF members the Graduate College will bill OMRF. This policy will be in place for the following doctoral programs: Biochemistry & Molecular Biology, Cell Biology, Microbiology & Immunology, Neuroscience, Pathology, Pharmaceutical Sciences and Physiology.

Approved at GPiBS Oversight Committee Meeting June 28, 2006. Amended January 24, 2014 to include Pharmaceutical Science. Amended August 2018 to bill outside OUHSC departments that host students from the seven biomedical programs.
