ELIGIBILITY

Any student who is close to graduating with a PhD or MS degree.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Nominations should be submitted <u>as a single PDF</u>. Please make sure the PDF is text-searchable.

The package should include, in this order:

- 1. Letter from the student, maximum 2 pages in length, in which they describe their research, articulate their overall merit and creative contribution to the health sciences, and explain why they deserve the award.
- 2. Letter of support from the Program Director or Department Chair
- 3. The student's CV

The student should submit the nomination package. Email the package to <u>Gillian-air@ouhsc.edu</u> with a cc to <u>catina-jordan@ouhsc.edu</u> by <u>5 pm, Monday, February 11, 2019</u>.

SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCEDURE

The Dean of the Graduate College will appoint a committee to assess the applicants. The main criterion is creative contribution to the health sciences, which may include novel ideas, technical innovation and potential for commercialization.
